



Professor emeritus Philip C. Grammaticos was born and lives in Thessaloniki, Macedonia, Greece. With his wife and colleague, Fani Melfou they have five children. They also have ten grandchildren. He served at the University Hospital AHEPA for 43 years in Internal Medicine and in Nuclear Medicine. He was member of the Royal Society of Medicine, London and of the New York Academy of Sciences. He is the first Professor of Nuclear Medicine in Greece. He published about 200 papers, some original. He is the founder and President of the International Medical Olympicus Association.

He organized 5 International Medical Olympiads. With 84 collaborators he wrote the first book of Nuclear Medicine in Greece, in 6 editions. He is the founder and now the Honorary President of the Hellenic Society of Nuclear Medicine. For 21 years he was the Editor-in-Chief of the Hell. J. Nucl. Med. He is the principal author of the International Neo-Hippocratic Medicine (INHM) book, now in its 5th edition. He is the first leptidopterist in Northern Greece and described the "Energy Functioning Independently-EFI" as published in the (INHM)book and in the Hell. J. Nucl. Med.
