



Despina Moraitou is Associate Professor of Cognitive GeroPsychology in the School of Psychology and member of the Laboratory of Neurodegenerative Diseases in the CIRI, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Greece. She is author and co-author of more than 100 peer-review articles and chapters published in international and Greek journals and volumes as well as of more than 200 presentations, invited and others, in international and Greek conferences. She is Co-Editor (2015-) of the interdisciplinary forum “Journal of Happiness Studies”. She is President (2018-2022) of the Division 7 – Applied Gerontology / GeroPsychology of the International Association of Applied Psychology (IAAP). Her research interests lie on the

psychology of lifespan development and aging, on methods and assessment issues, as well as on the design of experiments in cognitive psychology field.
